Ulrich Baretzky – Audi Sport



Ulrich Baretzky is Head of Engine Technology at Audi Sport. He was born in 1954 in Straubing, Bavaria and studied Mechanical Engineering at the University of Munich. He began his career as a Design Engineer with BMW Motorsport and then moved to Audi as head of Race Engine Design in 1986.

He led projects in Trans-Am, IMSA GTO, DTM, ITC and in 1993, became the Head of Race & Special Engine Development at Audi Sport. His project at Audi Sport include Supertouring, Audi Le Mans, (victories in 2000, 2001, 2002, 2004, 2005, 2006, 2007), Bentley Le Mans, (victory in 2003), ALMS, LMES, DTM and STCC.

In 2002, he was made the Coordinator of Race Engines within the VW Group and has led the Skoda WRC, SEAT ETCC, WTCC Lamborghini GT and F3 projects.
